The **joint DME MAC public meeting** on **August 26, 2015** was well-attended by amputees and practitioners alike. BOC was well-represented at this meeting, and approximately 50 speakers shared their thoughts about the LCD for lower limb prostheses. We are very proud of the BOC-certified practitioners -- including **Jeff Zeller, BOCPO, CP** and **Jeff Arnette, BOCPO, CPO** -- who spoke at this meeting! BOC'S Regulatory & Legislative Analyst **Zack Chait** and I also were present.

Although the stories and facts presented at this meeting were powerful and compelling, **those public comments will NOT be used to re-evaluate the Draft LCD. Medicare will only consider WRITTEN COMMENTS.** The more comments we send, the stronger our unified voice will be.

To All BOC Constituents,

You undoubtedly have heard about the DME MACs¹ joint publication of a draft LCD² for lower limb prosthetic coverage. BOC and our sister organizations within the orthotics & prosthetics (O&P) community are concerned that if this proposal becomes policy, new coverage, coding, and clinical care guidelines will **drastically restrict** amputees' access to lower limb prosthetics. For a more detailed look at the potential effects of this proposal, please review this [executive summary](#) from the American Orthotic Prosthetic Association (AOPA).

Every member of the O&P community needs to **take action now! If you do nothing else, please sign a very important petition** that asks the Obama administration to rescind this proposal. If the petition garners **100,000 signatures in 30 days** (by **August 31, 2015**), the White House staff will review it, send it to the appropriate policy experts, and issue an official response.

Practitioners also may [submit comments on the proposed policy](#) to their Senators and Congressional Representatives by easily customizing a letter created by AOPA.
