John Kenney, MURP, BOCO, Chairman of the BOC Board of Directors said, "BOC realizes the importance of outcomes and evidence-based research in the O&P field, and is pleased to support COPL's excellent work in this area."

In a letter of appreciation to BOC on behalf of the COPL Board of Directors, COPL President William J. Barringer applauded the BOC effort saying, "Your commitment to the importance of outcomes and evidence-based research in our field as being paramount for the continued success of the constituencies we serve is most gratifying.
